UNITED WAY DAY OF ACTION

Over 200 people made their way through the Asbury Resource Center (ARC) for the United Way Day of Action. The Resource Fair provided 134 Lincoln County children with clothing, school supplies and food, plus access to numerous agencies and services.



CHRISTMAS GALA

The first annual Carolina Christmas Gala brought together close to 100 people from our community for a festive evening of live music, food, and fellowship and raised over \$12,000 to improve lives right here in Lincoln County.

Connection for a Cause meets monthly to help non-profits and agencies take a more comprehensive view of the needs of our community and to address those needs in a holistic way. The partnership is focused on solutions for stabilizing, strengthening, and building self-reliance for people in Lincoln County.



EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM (EFSP)

United Way of Lincoln County administers EFSP funding and worked with a team of community leaders to secure \$37,481 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs offered by the Hessed House of Hope and the Lincoln County Coalition Against Domestic Violence.
