The first annual Carolina Christmas Gala brought together close to 100 people from our community for a festive evening of live music, food, and fellowship and raised over \$12,000 to improve lives right here in Lincoln County.

EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM (EFSP)

United Way of Lincoln County administers EFSP funding and worked with a team of community leaders to secure \$37,481 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs offered by the Hesed House of Hope and the Lincoln County Coalition Against Domestic Violence.


